Background

Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother Hospital is part of the East Kent NHS Foundation Trust. It is an acute hospital which provides a range of emergency and elective services. The original building was constructed in the 1930s, and between 1966 and 1998 the hospital services were relocated and expanded into a new main building linked to the original facilities. The project's client was RemPods Ltd, a company established in 2013 thanks to the BBC TV programme Dragon's Den. RemPods have an ethos to transform clinical environments into therapeutic and reminiscent spaces, helping to change the quality of life for the individuals living with dementia.

Scope of Works

Springbank Contractors Ltd were appointed to replace the previous kitchenette in the St Augustine's ward day room, replacing it with a circa 1960s/70s style functioning kitchenette. This included worktops, cupboards, cupboard fronts and handles, a sink, microwave, washing machine, hob and an under counter fridge. Springbank also removed the carpet from the lounge area, replacing with a new dementia-friendly Polyflor. The entire day room was decorated in keeping with the circa 1960s/70s theme, including finishing touches such as radiator covers and 1970s TV and TV cabinet.
